Pinacoteca

It is housed in a 1900 building designed to be the headquarters of the Lyceum of Arts and Crafts. It is the oldest art museum in São Paulo, founded in 1905 and passed through an acclaimed renovation conducted by the architect Paulo Mendes da Rocha in the 1990s.

The São Paulo Pinacoteca house is one of the largest and most representative collections of Brazilian art, with almost ten thousand pieces covering mostly the history of Brazilian painting of the 19th and 20th centuries. Also remarkable are the Nemirovsky Collection, with an expressive set of masterpieces of Brazilian modernism and, more recently, the Roger Wright Collection, received in 2015, with iconic masterpieces of the Brazilian contemporary art.

Memorial da Resistência de São Paulo

The Memorial da Resistência [Memorial of Resistance] of São Paulo is an institution dedicated to preserving references of memories of political repression and resistance in Republican Brazil (1889 to the present day) by turning into a memorial part of the building which between 1940 and 1983 housed the Departamento Estadual de Ordem Política e Social de São Paulo [State Department of Political and Social Order of São Paulo] – Deops/SP, one of the most violent and aggressive police forces in Brazil, especially during the military dictatorship (1964-1985).
